



CUB SCOUT CAMPING – CHECK LIST

The following items are suggestions only:

EACH PERSON:

- Sleeping Bag
- Sleeping pad (for comfort and thermal protection)
- Extra Blanket (comes in handy if it's cool)
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Change of clothes (underwear, socks, pants, shirt)
- Cub Scout Uniform (might leave belt loops at home)
- Sleepwear
- Toboggan (another handy item if it gets cool a night)
- Hat
- Coat, jacket, thermals, gloves (**check the weather**)
- Durable, closed toe shoes
- Rain gear
- Fork, spoon, plate, cup
- Canteen or water bottle
- Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, sanitizing wipes)

EACH FAMILY:

- Tent
- Tent stakes
- Ground cloth (plastic to put under tent)
- Camp Chairs (one for each family member)
- Cooler with ice (keep your food cool)
- Food (meals and snacks)
- Drinking Water
- Camping Stove w/ fuel (NO liquid fuels please)
- Camping/Cooking table (something small that folds)
- Small Hand-broom w/ dust pan (for sweeping your tent)
- Sun screen
- Toilet Paper
- Personal Medication and First Aid
- Hand Sanitizing Lotion and Wipes
- Smiling Face

GENERAL COOKING SUPPLIES:

- Lighter
- Cookware (spatula, tongs, spoons, knife, etc)
- Pots / Skillet / Frying pan
- Coffee pot (heating water for coffee/hot chocolate)
- Food / Snacks / Beverages / Coffee / Hot Chocolate
- Salt / Pepper / Condiments
- Hand Pads (for handling hot cookware)
- Marshmallows (stick or metal rod for cooking)
- Plastic / Paper Cups, Plates, Utensils, Bowls
- Coffee/Hot Chocolate Mugs (ones w/ lids work great)
- Paper towels, Napkins
- Soap
- Dish towel
- Can Opener
- Garbage Bags
- Aluminum Foil
- Large bowl or tub for washing any dishes
- Remember to bring Smiling Faces

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Personal Heaters
- Pets
- Firearms, sheathed knives, bow/arrows, bb, paint, or pellet guns, sling-shots
- Liquid fuel
- Cutting devices (axes, chainsaws)
- Generators
- Electronics (radios, TVs, video games)
- ATVs, bikes, scooters
- Alcohol is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
